Successful Grants

2016 has been a successful year for funding and grants. The Strategic Plan describes the infrastructure required to develop and maintain the facilities. Successful funding and grants include: **\$100,000** from the Snowy Valleys Shire (committed by the former Tumbarumba Shire) for the Pavilion. **\$800** from the Tumbarumba Community Small Grants Program for signage. **\$4,500** from the NSW Government's Public Reserve

A \$50000 application for fitting out the Pavilion will be submitted on 26th August to the Snowy Valleys Council Small Grants scheme.
