Animals and Biosecurity

Horses, Cattle and Poultry exhibits certainly provide the "country" atmosphere (and aroma!) to our annual show. If you are an exhibitor we encourage you to familiarise yourself with your obligations in relation to biosecurity for the safety and welfare of your own, and other animals on exhibit and on your home property.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to present an animal at the show in a state of excellent health and manage the animal whilst at the show to minimise stress and the possible cross contamination of pathogens between individual animals.

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The onus is on the exhibitor to ensure that the animal is vaccinated in accordance to protocol (check with your vet) and be aware that our facilities are such that we cannot provide a high degree of segregation of stock.

All animals need to have relevant documentation completed *prior* to delivery to the showgrounds and copies of these documents must be handed to the steward on arrival. Details of these documents are printed in the 2017 Jingellic Show Schedule and the Horse Schedule which can be accessed on our website:

Judged "on farm" in your own environment. Open to all breeds

Successful Grants

2016 was a very successful year with grants totalling \$246,000 as follows:

- **\$100,000** Snowy Valleys Council (SVC): Pavilion
- **\$50,000** SVC Special Grants Clean Water Clean Catering
- **\$91,8000** Club Grants Emergency Welfare Centre
- **\$6,500** Community Building Partnerships: Solar power and security lighting
- **\$800** Tumbarumba Community Small Grants Program: Signage
- **\$4,500** NSW Government's Public Reserve: Fencing
- **\$500** Australia Post: Stamps
- **\$1,500** HVP Plantations

Infra structure update

A Master Plan for the Grounds has been developed and available to anyone interested. The Plan will be on display at the Show.

Old Pavilion: has been demolished and the concrete will be used for road fill.

The **new Pavilion** site is ready for the footings to go in, and the plumber and concreters to move on their respective jobs. The building will commence in 2 weeks.

The **Former Canteen:** the canteen has now become the maintenance shed, which houses the generator. and the pump. The **Former Bar** has been dismantled and recycled and some of the timber will be re-used inside the new pavilion.

Fencing: Snowy Valley Shire plan to continue clearing the elm suckers on Jingellic South Rd. Once this is complete, new fences will be erected on the W, S and E boundaries.

New access: A Rural Access application has been submitted to SVC to construct access to Jingellic Sth Rd just north of the southern fence line. This will improve emergency vehicle access to the Pavilion.

Grounds: A mowing roster has been commenced. Thank you to the volunteers.

Plans are in place for the **new entrance**, and look out for the **new Showground sign** soon to be erected.
