Fencing: Snowy Valley Council plan to continue clearing the elm suckers on Jingellic South Rd. Once this is complete, new fences will be erected on the W, S and E boundaries.

New access: A Rural Access application has been submitted to Snowy Valley Council to construct access to Jingellic Sth Rd just north of the southern fence line. This will improve emergency vehicle access to the Pavilion.
